Not all waste is created equal! Be sure to put your garbage out correctly by sorting it and then taking it to your nearest collection point at the right time on the right day! We also thank you for your cooperation in keeping our community clean and beautiful by helping to keep your collection location neat and tidy!

Waste Categories

* Please be sure to use the officially designated Shimosuwa Garbage Bags

Bags from other municipalities will not be collected! **Burnable Waste (2x week)**



Recyclables (1x week)

Transparent bag with blue text. 19 types of recyclables (cans, bottles, papers, etc.)



Translucent pink bag with red text. Burnable items that cannot be recycled



Landfill Waste (1x/month)

Transparent bag with green text. Waste that cannot be recycled or burned.

■ Basic Rules for Putting out the Garbage Items disposed of improperly will not be collected!

- o Please use the official garbage bags designated by Shimosuwa for each type of waste.
- Please WRITE YOUR FULL NAME and TIE OFF EACH BAG (don't use tape to seal bags closed).
- Please use your NEAREST COLLECTION LOCATION and put your garbage out on the CORRECT COLLECTION DAY! Note that recyclables collection varies each week, so be sure to check the Recycling Calendar to confirm collection before putting out the recycling. Also, make sure to sort recyclables into separate bags by type. (Note that paper recycling does not need to be placed into an official bag. Also, used batteries, fluorescent tubes, and light bulbs may be placed in the same bag together).
- Regardless of what time the collection vehicle arrives, please put out your waste for collection at your local collection location between dawn (around 6 AM) and 8 AM on the day of collection.
- o Each household remains responsible for its own garbage until it has been collected. Be sure to check to make sure your own garbage has been collected!

So as not to inconvenience residents living near waste collection points, and in order to keep our community clean, please be sure to keep your local collection location neat and tidy,

● Collection Days * Garbage is collected 3x/week (Burnable Waste 2x, Recyclables 1x; Landfill Waste 1x/month)

Garbage collection days are generally determined by local residents' associations. If you have any questions about your nearest collection location or collection days, please ask a neighbor or inquire at the Town Office.

Business Waste

Waste produced by commercial operators (companies, factories, shops, restaurants, etc.) is treated as Business Waste and is not eligible for collection from local collection locations. Business owners are asked to hire a licensed operator or else to transport waste themselves to the appropriate disposal location (Recyclable and Landfill Waste to the Sanitation Center and Burnable Waste to the Lake Suwa Clean Center). (Acceptable materials are identical to those accepted as Household

Handling fees for Business Waste are 160 yen per 10 kg. Note that processing fees will be calculated by weight even if




Items from which metal parts are not easily removed (tires, batteries, bicycles, electric blankets, electric carpets, sprung mattresses, fire extinguishers, etc.)

Non-recyclable papers

- Carefully check the "Papers" section on the back of this sheet. Note that cartons with foil interiors (liquor cartons, etc.), papers soiled with oil or food waste, waterproofed paper (waxed paper cups, etc.), and photo paper cannot be recycled. Please dispose of these as Burnable Waste.
- Be sure to sort out recyclable materials for recycling!



Non-recyclable fabrics

- Clothing, fabrics, and leather items that cannot be re-used. Please check the "Used Fabrics" section (right) to confirm.
- Please take futon mattresses, carpets, and other items that will not fit into the designated garbage bags directly to the Lake Suwa Clean Center or put them out for collection as Oversized / Dangerous Waste.
- Be sure to sort what is recyclable from what is not!



Tree & Grass Clippings, Fallen Leaves, Garden Waste

- Tree clippings, etc. should be less than 25 cm around and cut to 60 cm in length, then tied in bundles of less than 30 cm thick and wrapped in a 45² Shimosuwa Burnable Waste bag labelled with your name.
- Waste OTHER THAN tree clippings will not be collected, even if wrapped with a
- To dispose of grass, fallen leaves, and garden waste, shake off any dirt and remove any metal or plastics, then put them out for collection in a Shimosuwa Burnable Waste bag with your name on it.
- These materials are collected free of charge for part of the year (check the reverse of this page or the Shimosuwa Recycling Calendar for details).



In any case, let's try to compost clippings and other garden waste in our own gardens as much as possible!

Drain food waste as much as possible before putting it out for collection.

Food Waste

- Please make sure that no non-burnable waste (spoons, etc.) gets mixed in.
- Let's remember to always try to waste as little food as possible!
- Composting also helps to prevent the crows from making a mess of collection sites!



Food Waste Reduction Recycling Project

The Food Waste Reduction Recycling Center in Akasunasaki processes household food waste to convert it into compost for fertilizer. Food waste may be brought directly to the Center, or pick-up can be arranged as part of a group collection.

- The service is free of charge
- · Collection containers and bags are provided

Applications are accepted at any time. Feel free to ask at the Living Environment Section at the Shimosuwa Town Office. (Initial guidance will be provided. Please help us move this project smoothly forward in order to reduce burnable waste and create high-quality compost!)

Food Waste Processing Unit Subsidy

To reduce burnable waste by helping individual households process their own raw food waste, Shimosuwa is subsidizing the purchase and installation of food waste processing units (*values rounded to the nearest 100 yen)

- Per unit from 2,000 yen to 10,000 yen (tax included): Up to 80% of purchase price (maximum 5,000 yen)
- Per unit over 10,000 yen (tax included): Up to 66% of purchase price (maximum 50,000 yen)

Apply at the Residents' Environment Desk at the Town Office. (Please bring 1) the purchase receipt, 2) explanatory leaflet, and 3) banking information)
